The airframe is all 3D printed including the central fuel tank. Lots of redundancy, 2 electrical busses. 4 ailerons and 4 elevators.

2 OS FS engines. Navigation lights.

It is intended to carry a payload pod under the central wing. They were testing the autonomous control system so no pod attached.

Inside their van was like mission control.

The professional pilot. Paul Heckles, flew it conventionally using a Futaba Tx. (He has to do the CAA 'stuff ') He would give them control for a few seconds to do a test, for example instructing it to climb, then take back control.



Most of the time he was flying it while they got ready in the van for the next test. Although it is designed to fly autonomously beyond sight, he kept it within sight at all times. He had a ground spotter with him and they had voice radio link with the van.
