Important notice

To All members, especially for members who have not visited Thorney Island before. It is imperative that the the following access route is followed without exception

Pilot's Handbook, paras 5.3 and 5.4:

The correct route through the camp area is approximately 200 yards after the Guard-Gate, turn left at the first 5.3 entrance to the taxiways, . Follow the road past the front of the hangers, then crossing the main camp road follow the perimeter taxiway right round to the Club car Park. Members must observe the 30 mph speed limit at all times on all parts of the site.

5.4 With the exception of the access roads and designated flying area, all other areas of the base are out of bounds. No cars are to be taken onto the runway or take-off area during a flying session.

Providing the applicant has already undergone the initial Basic Check procedure, I will require one form of photo ID, CADMAC membership card and the tax disc to complete my documentation.
