KITTING OUT THE CORVUS

Since losing my much loved MX2 a few months back I've been looking for a new home for the DLA 32 engine, Savox servos and the rest of the paraphernalia. After many hours research on the interweb and much foot-slogging back and forth amongst the traders at Wings & Wheels I eventually settled on the Goldwing 77" Corvus Racer - most recognisable when in the 'Red Bull' livery.

I was very pleased with the quality of the majority of the kit. The leading edges of control surfaces are rounded to match the T/E section of the wings and are tab-hinged via a carbon fibre rod. There's a lot of C/F in the kit too with undercarriage, wing joiners and control horns as well as C/F strengtheners in the fuselage longerons. Other very flashy inclusions were the new Kuza tank system and the Kuza filler and overflow dots.

With engine mounted and servos installed I put the model on the balance only to discover that I'd have to but the bulk of the gear (RX excluded for spark interference reasons) up the sharp end. Over a week of machinations and deliberation went into the final solution which is shown below although I've had to add a little under 100g of lead to get the CG towards the nose heavy option.

It all looks pretty busy in there so I thought I'd knock out this schematic to mount alongside the model for the next static display. It'll make a welcome change from the old P51 - providing, of course, that she survives her maiden flight!
