Open Glider Competition 2015

This year the competition was again run over three days, three rounds per day.

On day one 15 pilots flew, the wind was 5-8 mph with very little lift to be found the best total times for the day were by Adrian Childs with 8min.16sec, Ray Beadle with 7min.47 sec and Nick Gates with 7min.25 sec.

Day two had winds of 8-10 mph. 13 pilots started, the best times for the day were by David Gardner with 7 min. 50 sec. however he could only fly once due to home requirements, Keith Watts with 7 min 01 sec and Nick Gates with 6 min 34 sec.

For day three 10 pilots flew, with winds of 10-14 mph Ray Beadle and Adrian Child managed the max of 10 min in the first round, and Keith Watts got 6 min 42sec.
