Ten pilots entered this year. Models included the normal fun flies, a Super Sixty and an electric Wot 4. Two rounds were to be flown, the lowest total distance from the spot was to be the winner.

John Riall started the first round and made a score of 43.5ft, followed by Tony Chant with a distance of 3 ft, here we go again!!

Harry Hook was next and managed to crash in the sea, bad luck Harry. Tony Coombes did a good 21ft followed by Mick Blundell with the trainer who managed 23ft.

A new flyer Harry Harrison entered an electric Wot 4 and managed 11ft and Peter Doe flew the trainer and did 77 ft.

Mick Blundell supervised two fledgling pilots, Trevor Humphrey and Keith Watts. Trevor managed 100ft followed by Keith with 105ft; Ray took the final slot and his bomb landed 35ft from the target.

In the second round John Riall managed 57ft and Tony only managed 16ft beaten by Harry Harrison who landed 8.5 ft from the spot, while Tony Combes was pleased to get 16 ft and Mick did 26 ft.

Peter got to 81ft while Trevor managed 54 ft and Keith made the farthest of the day with 129ft, while Ray only managed 82ft.

So after totalling the two rounds the results were,

Tony Coombes, third

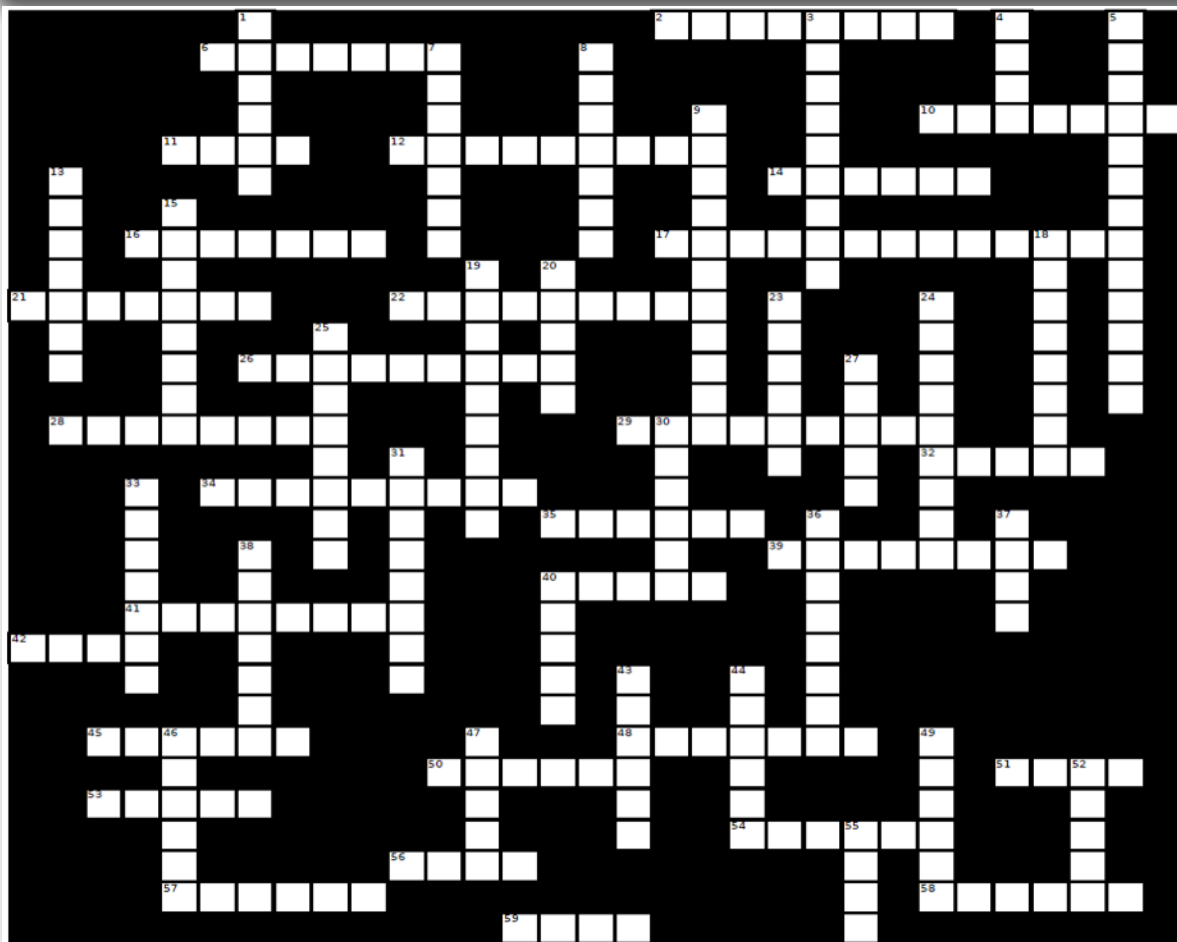

The Chain of Command has decided that, in future, all personnel, civilian or military, will have an annual expiry date on their vehicle pass that coincides with the expiry of their vehicle road tax.

I would appreciate it if you could circulate this direction to all of your club members and arrange for them to contact me in the New Year to arrange an appointment for a new pass to be issued.

In this connection, and, subject to other commitments, I will be available for pass renewal during the hours 0915-1215 & 1400-1600, Monday to Thursday. Providing the applicant has already undergone the initial Basic Check procedure, I will require one form of photo ID, CADMAC membership card and the tax disc to complete my documentation.
